Assessment of PO's & CO's

Attainment. The college monitors PO's & CO's of Relevant courses of the college evaluated through direct & indirect methods

A] Direct Method:-

1. The course outcome is assessed through internal examinations and final examination at the end of the semester.
2. The question papers of internal examinations are framed as per guidelines with course Outcomes & attainment is assessed from the answer books.
3. The results of final examinations are used to measure their attainment of PO's & CO's. The overall CO's is evaluated by taking the average percentage of attainment of internal & final examination.
4. The university examination results are put into result analysis meeting arranged by dept of college to assess attainment of PO's & CO's and necessary steps are taken in order to improve in certain areas.
5. For the improvement of PO's & CO's various co-curricular activities such as seminars, Group discussions, Workshops, Book review, projects, assignments etc are also useful

B] Indirect Method:-

1. Indirect evaluations are used as tools for the progression to higher studies, Alumni, course exit survey for each course & programme & survey for each programme.
2. Every Unit test questions, quiz & Laboratory performs & projects or assignments are mapped to the respective CO's
3. Assignment & Unit Test questions are designed as per PO's & CO's of the curriculum.
4. The Indirect method of assessment is done through feedback collected from outgoing students in the form of course exit survey. This feedback is useful for genuine opinion of the teachers & students in the CO's attainment which contribute to the PO attainment.
5. Attainment of PO's & CO's are evaluated by the institution.

6. The incrustation conducted by the Alumini association & meetings by which institute indirectly assesses the competency level of outgoing students.

7. Thus attainments of PO's & CO's are evaluated by the institution. We uploaded documents with related information on link.
